


Council ignores residents and agrees more high-rise flats



It was bad news for residents as councillors completely ignored valid objections and voted for another development of 84 flats in four blocks including one of 16 storeys at the end of Dunedin Road.

Focus Team member **Bob Sullivan**, with two other residents, spoke against the development at the Planning

Committee. Bob highlighted the fact that there were already the **Bywaters** plans for 685 flats of up to 15 storeys and the nearly finished **Leyton Central** development of 6 storeys of 116 flats on the corner of **Ruckholt Road** and the further proposals for development of the **Score** building in **Oliver Road** of another 600 residential units.

Bob said that the **Dunedin Road** development should not be decided on its own, but in conjunction with the other plans for the area. He called for an impact assessment to be done on traffic generation, building density, road capacity and the well-being of the nearby residents before any plans are looked at or decided on. The objections, made by Bob and the other residents, were completely ignored.

Focus says: It seems that the policy of our Labour Council is to use every bit of land for multi high rise flats.

Leyton Midland station - Better bus stops and pavements needed

Leyton Midland Road (LMR) station is at present shut for electrification works until February next year. LMR is already a busy station and when the line reopens there will be an increase in the numbers of commuters using the station. The bus stops in the **High Road** do not have any shelters so passengers have no cover in the event of rain, have difficulty standing and have nowhere to sit. The bus stop on the Stratford side of the **High Road** is situated on a very narrow pavement forcing passengers to take up the space and thus forcing passing pedestrians to walk in the road.

Focus is supporting a local resident in calling for bus shelters and enlarged pavements to be included in the proposed Mini Holland works due at the junction of **Coopers Lane** and the **High Road**.

Lib Dems choose 'Workers champion' for election!

Leyton and Wanstead Liberal Democrats have selected **Benjamin Sims** to take on local MP John Cryer in the event of an early General Election in a fight to become the next MP.

Burchell and Sophia Roads - unswept

Residents of **Burchell Road** and **Sophia Road** are fed up that their roads have not been swept for weeks. **Focus Team member Bob Sullivan** contacted the Council to investigate and to get the roads cleaned properly and to make sure that they are swept regularly.



Vicarage Road and Beaumont Estate parking nightmare!

A recent survey by the **Lib Dem Focus Team** in **Vicarage Road** and the **Beaumont Estate** area found that many residents complained about the problems they had with parking. **L&Q Housing Association** did a parking survey on the estate some months ago, but unfortunately this was not supported by the residents.

The news is that the Council is due to consult with all residents in the area in November on whether they would like a controlled parking zone (CPZ) in their road (See list of roads on the right). **It is important that all residents fill in the consultation form and send it back so that a decision can be made that reflects the genuine view of residents.**
